The Oddfellows provide a number of educational bursaries to members undertaking first time degree courses. These are allocated on a competition basis and are judged on a number of criteria. The winners receive a substantial financial award for each year of their course. Members need to have been in the Oddfellows for five continuous years in order to apply.

- **Savings on Adult Membership**

When your child reaches 18 they can take up adult membership of the Oddfellows. Depending on when the child joined, they could save money on up to four years FREE adult membership. See the table below for saving entitlements once they turn 18.
