It's not just adults who can enjoy the benefits of Oddfellows membership; anyone from newborn to 17 years old can join the Young Oddfellows. With benefits especially for them, there's every reason to give your child a great start in life.

Become a Young Oddfellow today - it's really easy

Just £10 a year will entitle your child to:

- **A £5 Gift Voucher***
Every Christmas young Oddfellows receive a Christmas card with a £5 gift voucher to spend on what ever takes their fancy!
- **Orphan Gift Fund***
The Oddfellows provides the opportunity for a child who loses one or both parents to apply for weekly financial support and regular contact until the end of their full time education. This by no means compensates for their loss, but knowing that the Oddfellows is there with support can go a long way.
- **Social Events**
A number of local Branches arrange events for young members. Contact your local Branch Secretary for more details.
- **Educational and Apprenticeship Awards***
The Oddfellows provides a number of educational bursaries to members undertaking first time degree courses or apprenticeships. These are allocated

on a competition basis and are judged on a number of criteria. The winners receive a substantial financial award for each year of their course. Members need to have been in the Oddfellows for five continuous years in order to apply.

- **Savings on Adult Membership**
When your child reaches 18 they can take up adult membership of the Oddfellows. Depending on when the child joined, they could save money on up to four years of FREE adult membership. See the table below for saving entitlements once they turn 18.**

Age at time of joining	Number of years of FREE adult membership
0-5 years	4
6-10 years	3
11-13 years	2
14-17 years	1

Direct Debit Guarantee

This Guarantee should be retained by the Payer.

This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit Scheme.

The efficiency and security of the Scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society.

If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change, the Oddfellows will notify you at least 14 working days in advance of your account being debited as otherwise agreed.

If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by the Oddfellows or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund of the amount from your Bank or Building Society. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when the Oddfellows asks you to.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to the Oddfellows.
