For just £10 a year, they can:

- **Have fun making friends and doing new things**

Many of our events are family-friendly, with some designed just for Young Oddfellows.

- **Treat themselves every Christmas***

Every Christmas, we'll send them a £5 gift card to spend on what they fancy.

- **Receive care and welfare help***

If ever they feel the need to chat something over with us, they can. Care and Welfare support is available at their Branch, through the Care and Welfare Helpline, the Oddfellows Citizens Advice Line and through our Convalescence and Care Support benefits.

- **Receive financial help if the unthinkable happens***

If they ever lose one or both of their parents, then we'll support them where we can through their education, training or first job. Our Orphan Gift Fund can

provide financial support to help fund things such as school uniforms, books, musical instruments and school trips.

- **Apply for an Educational Award to help advance their career***

We grant up to three First Degree Course Educational Awards (£900 each year) for the duration of a student's first degree programme and up to three Apprenticeship Educational Awards (£250 each year) for the duration of the apprenticeship.

- **Additional Young Oddfellows benefits***

Being a Young Oddfellow means they're also eligible for Benevolence Grants to help through difficult times, Accidental Death Benefit, money-saving offers, our Legal Aid Scheme and Emergency Financial Aid (Household).

Direct Debit Guarantee

This Guarantee should be retained by the Payer.



This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit Scheme.

The efficiency and security of the Scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society.

If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change, the Oddfellows will notify you at least 14 working days in advance of your account being debited as otherwise agreed.

If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by the Oddfellows or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund of the amount from your Bank or Building Society. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when the Oddfellows asks you to.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to the Oddfellows.

When they get older, being a Young Oddfellow also means they could:

- **Enjoy savings on Adult Membership****

When they reach 18, they could save up to four years on the cost of annual adult membership, depending on when they joined.
