





The value of telephone support has been clearly demonstrated during the pandemic. Receiving telephone calls and knowing that other people cared helped all of us to cope in this strange unprecedented time.

We are looking for volunteers to keep in touch with members by telephone, offering a listening ear and support to those who may need it due to old age, ill health, disability, caring responsibilities, bereavement, isolation and other difficult situations. Sometimes the role can include signposting members to other sources of support.

If you become a Telephone Befriender, you will attend an induction course and will be supported by the Branch and national Care Department. This means you would not have to deal with anything on your own.

A basic DBS check is needed for this role.
