## Chairman's Charity of the Year

#### (February 2024 – February 2025) Update

Three Counties Dog Rescue, based in Bourne received a £3,250 donation from the Branch in May. The Charity was chosen by Janice Bedford, as her Chairman's Charity of the Year. The donation was raised through a number of events, including Barry Bedford (present Chairman) raising over £700 by doing a Sponsored Slim.

Three Counties Dog Rescue was founded in 1971. Gyll Mauchline joined soon after and has continued to develop the Rescue in Lincolnshire following her move re-homing dogs within a 50 mile radius of its base in South Lincolnshire.

Animals are re-homed in Lincolnshire, Leicestershire, Rutland, Cambridgeshire, Northamptonshire and Nottinghamshire.

Gyll said "Recently we have taken in some cats due to other Rescue doors being closed. We are very grateful to Nene & Welland Oddfellows for their donation, it will assist towards meeting our vet bills that run to around £180,000 per annum. Currently, on top of the day to day vet costs, pug type dogs have become popular and we have two that need operations to free up their air flows as the breeding has restricted their breathing."

## **Touch of Sparkle**

Touch of Sparkle was established in 2015 and donates cancer care packs to patients at Addenbrooke's, Hinchingbrooke and Peterborough hospitals. Each year, they also make a donation of reward toys to children at Addenbrooke's for children undergoing a test or procedure. This is their 10th anniversary year and in that time, they've donated over 7,500 cancer care packs and 12,000 toys for children.

Founder, Melanie said "We were delighted to receive a donation of £250 from the Oddfellows Nene and Welland District Lodge this year. These funds were put towards a batch of 50 care packs donated to the Peterborough Hospital Oncology Day Unit in March 2025. This donation marked our 7,500 care pack milestone!"

The cancer care packs contain a mix of practical items, distractions and treats with the idea being to add a caring and personal touch to the clinical cancer treatment process. The packs include items such as herbal teas (for nausea), bed socks, puzzle books, earplugs, notebooks, lip balms, playing cards, mini toiletries for hospital stays, sweets and chocolates, mints, biscuits/flapjacks, pocket tissues etc.

The care packs are given out to adult patients of all ages and at all stages of



to those paid for by our donation.

treatment (surgery, radiotherapy and chemotherapy). The aim is to bring comfort and kindness during cancer treatment. We have had some lovely feedback from patients over the last 10 years to say that the care packs brought relief at a really difficult time, making hospital stays and treatments a little easier. Melanie wanted to say "Thank you to the Nene and Welland District Lodge for helping us to spread a 'touch of sparkle' to cancer patients in Peterborough."

This means that the whole of the field can now be used for planting by the farmer (previously there was a large area that was always flooded). In addition, the Branch has carried out a number of maintenance works at the hall, with



repairs to the roof and improved accessibility to the hall.

## Scarborough hosts the nation's Oddies



For the 20th time in more than 200 years the Society's Annual Movable Conference (AMC) was held in beautiful Scarborough, hosted by Vale of York Oddfellows.

Members representing their Branches converged on the seaside town from

Nur Zainal, who's PhD at the University of Southampton has been supported by the HA Andrews Memorial Fund, and Professor of Cancer Biology Tim Fenton (pictured), addressed the Society's annual conference as three years of funding comes to an end.

"My PhD – made possible by the generous support of the Oddfellows – has made some significant contributions to cancer research," said Nur. "My ultimate goal is to find ways to prevent or overcome drug resistance, and my model will let us run

the pre-clinical studies needed to move promising strategies toward the clinic."

Tim added: "Until recently, we did not understand enough about how our immune system recognises and responds to tumours, or about how tumours learn to switch off our immune responses



to deploy cancer vaccines effectively. This is changing rapidly, and cancer vaccines hold great promise for kinder, more effective therapy, though significant challenges remain."
