




Paying your membership by Direct Debit

A new Direct Debit payment initiative was launched in January to try to make membership payments easier. So why choose Direct Debit?

- It is easy to set up, it can be done over the phone or online.
- You don't need to worry about renewing each year as the Direct Debit will automatically be taken upon your renewal date.
- You still have complete control because you can cancel whenever you want – you'll be notified of the payment 6-8 weeks in advance to give you plenty of time to make any changes.
- It's paperless and nothing has to go through the post, so no danger of it going astray.
- It is all done on a totally secure system.
- You can choose to make the membership payment over two consecutive months to help you manage your finances.
- Standard membership would be two monthly payment of £12.50 and extra benefits would be two monthly payments of £17.50.

We're now Carbon Neutral Plus

In our second year of calculating and offsetting our annual carbon footprint, the Society's central offices in Manchester and Liverpool have been certified as Carbon Neutral Plus.

Between 1 April 2021 and 31 March 2022, 100.89 tonnes of CO2e were recorded as being produced, which has been offset through tree planting projects in the UK and a deforestation prevention initiative in Brazil.

Our annual assessments not only track how much greenhouse gas we produce, but also identify ways in which we can reduce our carbon footprint. A number of measures have already been put in place, such as switching the Manchester office's energy tariffs from 'brown' to 'green' and installing LED lighting



which operates on a timed or sensor system.
