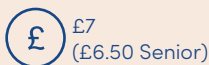

We're now Carbon Neutral Plus

In our second year of calculating and offsetting our annual carbon footprint, the Society's central offices in Manchester and Liverpool have been certified as Carbon Neutral Plus.

Between 1 April 2021 and 31 March 2022, 100.89 tonnes of CO₂e were recorded as being produced, which has been offset through tree planting projects in the UK and a deforestation prevention initiative in Brazil.

Our annual assessments not only track how much greenhouse gas we produce, but also identify ways in which we can reduce our carbon footprint. A number of measures have already been put in place, such as

switching the Manchester office's energy tariffs from 'brown' to 'green' and installing LED lighting

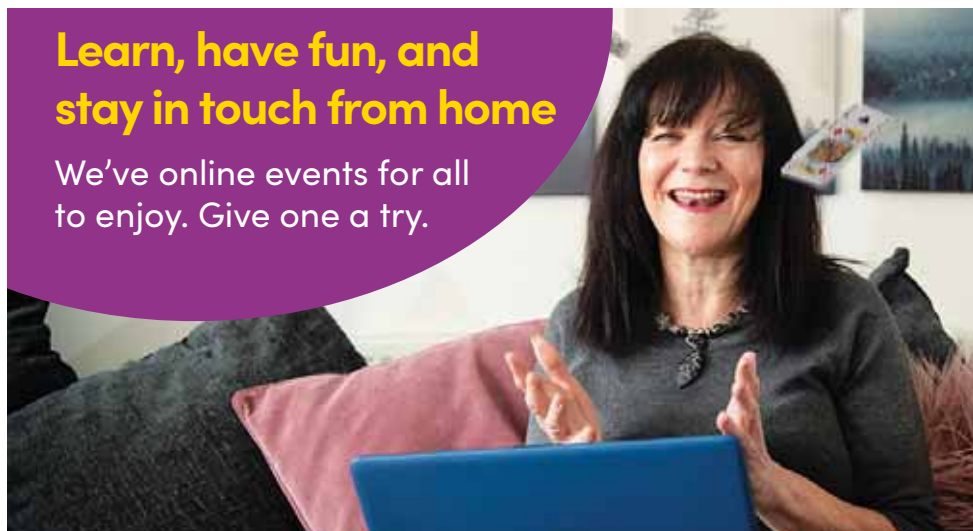


which operates on a timed or sensor system.
