My name is Elaine and I have been a carer as well as a campaigner for most of my adult life.

Three of my four children have Autism and learning disabilities and four years ago my husband was diagnosed with Dementia.

After many years of raising awareness about autism, I am now part of Dementia Carers Action Group working in partnership with the Alzheimer's Society, Memory Action Group based in Wakefield and The Prince of Wales Hospice Pontefract.

We identify policies and practices that aren't working effectively for people living with dementia and/or their carers. We then meet with various teams or boards to initiate change and improve lives whilst being aware of budget limitations.

The Prince of Wales hospice were asked to nominate carers to attend a reception at Windsor Castle with the King and Queen, who were shining a spotlight on carers.

I was nominated, along with three others carers who also volunteer, to attend the reception. The hospice provided a car and a volunteer drove us to Windsor and back.



We all had an unforgettable experience. Inside the Castle everyone was very welcoming and put us at ease. We were treated to drinks and very tasty canapés. There were other members of the Royal Family present alongside a few politicians and some celebrities.

The King entered the room where we were standing. He shook hands with us and spent some time chatting, before working his way up the room to other carers. The Queen began at the opposite end of the room.

I feel very honoured to have been nominated and it's an experience I never expected and certainly will never forget.
