

Natural History Museum at Tring

Grenville members and friends visited the private extensive collection of Lionel Walter Rothschild, 2nd Baron Rothschild (1868–1937). With six galleries, each housing different sets of animals with over 4,900 specimens and the Rothschild room there was much to see and learn in this former Rothschild family home. We saw extinct animals and birds as well as oddities and hybrids. The most famous exhibit are the dressed fleas which were handmade and sold to tourists in Mexico around 1905.


