

Hilary Roper is a published author and illustrator of children's books and professional fine artist. Born in Preston Hilary is actively painting and trading, producing books, painting in oils on canvas and giving lectures. Her first children's book, 'Macfaddion's Finest Hour', was published in



1990. Each illustration is highly detailed and painted in gouache and wax varnished. The story is about a water vole called Macfaddion, a barge owner who goes in hunt for a dragon–monster, who he can invite to the Gala day, in order to bring in tourists and money for the villagers. This set of illustrations has in each one, a hidden dragon–monster.

This is just a sample of Hilary's often award-winning work over the years with some illustrations selling for thousands at auction. Join us as Hilary talks through three to four children's book illustrations (with full visuals) telling the audience how she writes a fairy tale, treasure book, certain strategies, a short review of each story line and how to marry the illustrations with each story and where and how she creates the ideas and ethos and empathy within each storyline. New recipient of HA Andrews Memorial Fund

The new recipient of our UK medical research fund, the HA Andrews Memorial Fund, was agreed at this year's annual conference.



From 2022 to 2024, we're supporting the Centre for Cancer Immunology based at the University of Southampton. £100,000 in funding has been granted to enable the Centre's study of a specific gene which it is believed can be manipulated to target cancer cells in a new vaccine.

The ultimate goal is to create a vaccine that could fundamentally change outcomes for patients with cancer, particularly lung, breast, head, neck oesophageal and bladder cancers. The research is led by Dr Tim Fenton and Professor Edd James who will also be supervising a full-time PHD student funded by the Oddfellows.



We look forward to hearing how the Centre's research is progressing and sharing some insights with you when the Board makes its first visit later in the year.
